AND NOW, to wit, this 19th day of March, 2010, following a conference with counsel on March 18, 2010, the Court-appointed Discovery Master, Harris T. Bock, Esquire, hereby


ORDERS as follows:

1. A further conference with the Discovery Master and all counsel electing to participate will be held in the offices of **Raymond M. Williams, Esquire of DLA Piper, One Liberty Place, 1650 Market Street, Suite 4900, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, 19103, on Thursday, March 25, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.;**
2. All plaintiffs' counsel who wish to participate via telephone conference should contact Buffy K. Martines, Esquire via email at buffym@lpm-triallaw.com or via telephone (713-292-2750), and all defense counsel who wish to participate via telephone conference should contact Megan E. Grossman, Esquire via email at mgrossman@smsm.com or via telephone (215-399-2003).
3. As soon as practicable prior to the upcoming conference, counsel shall submit to the Discovery Master an updated Plaintiff's Fact Sheet reflecting mutually agreed

upon changes and any changes ordered by the Discovery Master, as well as references to any remaining outstanding disputed items.

4. As soon as practicable prior to the upcoming conference, counsel shall submit to the Discovery Master a specific agenda regarding issues to be addressed at the March 25, 2010 conference, along with any supporting materials for the Discovery Master to review prior to the conference.
5. Defense counsel shall initiate inquiry regarding an acceptable copying service to be utilized in connection with obtaining various medical, pharmaceutical, governmental, and insurance records in connection with the pending litigation. The selection of a copy service shall be subject to approval of plaintiff's counsel and shall be able to satisfy the following criteria:
 - a. The company has a headquarters or large presence in Philadelphia;
 - b. The hard-copy of all records shall be maintained in Philadelphia;
 - c. The company shall have nationwide capabilities to obtain records;
 - d. The service shall have the capability to provide for online record review from any remote access;
 - e. The company will hopefully be able to electronically notify counsel when any record is received; and
 - f. The entity does not have a special or unique relationship with any of the defendants or defense counsel beyond obtaining records.
