DISCOVERY MASTER ORDER NO. 39


AND NOW, to wit, this 3rd day of June, 2011, the Court-appointed Discovery Master, Harris T. Bock, Esquire, hereby **ORDERS** as follows:

1. **Wyeth's Production of A.H. Robins Documents:** Counsel shall meet and confer and provide a status update to the Discovery Master by the close of business on Friday, June 10, 2011. In the interim, all obligations of Wyeth regarding the production of the A.H. Robins documents are stayed.
2. **Modification of the Trial Schedule Protocol:** Plaintiffs may submit to the Discovery Master by the end of the calendar day today, June 3, 2011, their position as to why CMO 13 (specifically subparagraph (5)(b)) should be revised. Defendants may submit a response by the close of business on Monday, June 6, 2011.
3. **Limitations of Physician/Provider Depositions:** The Discovery Master will not limit the number of depositions that defendants may take of plaintiffs' physicians. However, plaintiffs may seek relief from the Discovery Master at any time if plaintiffs believe defendants' noticing of such depositions is abusive, harassing, and/or unnecessary. If it is found that depositions are noticed in bad faith, then

sanctions will be imposed.

4. **Master Second Set of Discovery Requests:** Counsel shall meet and confer as to whether Discovery Master Order 37(3)(c) regarding the production of Citizens Petitions in accordance with RFP 10 should be limited to generic defendants, or apply to all defendants. Counsel shall provide a status update to the Discovery Master by the close of business on Friday, June 10, 2011.
5. **Future Privilege Challenges:** In accordance with Discovery Master Order 34(2), counsel shall meet and confer regarding the development of a rolling review of challenges to privilege assertions. Counsel shall discuss, *inter alia*, a protocol involving more elaborate privilege log descriptions to better convey the basis of the assertion, as well as a protocol for addressing and reviewing parent-child documents. Counsel shall be prepared to discuss such a protocol in detail at the June 14, 2011 Discovery Master conference.
