
DISCOVERY MASTER ORDER NO. 5

AND NOW, to wit, this 12th day of April, 2010, the Court-appointed Discovery Master, Harris T. Bock, Esquire, hereby **ORDERS** as follows:

1. With respect to the Plaintiff Fact Sheet, plaintiffs' counsel objected to the inclusion of seven specific medical history requests regarding plaintiffs' parents and siblings in Section III(B)(5), namely schizophrenia, psychosis, bipolar disorder, depression, anxiety disorder, mood disorder, and suicidal ideation.
2. As a result of a careful *in camera* review of the materials submitted by DLC, the Discovery Master orders the following:
 - a. Section III(B)(5) shall include the following disputed items: schizophrenia, psychosis, and bipolar disorder.
 - b. Depression, anxiety disorder, mood disorder, and suicidal ideation shall be stricken from Section III(B)(5).
 - c. At or before the April 21, 2010 Discovery Master conference, counsel shall submit to the Discovery Master the final agreed-upon Plaintiff Fact Sheet, which will be posted on the online docket at www.adrdri.com.

3. At the April 7, 2010 Discovery Master conference, Attorney Williams and plaintiffs' counsel engaged in a conversation regarding the possibility of reaching an agreement that would permit the plaintiffs to preserve their potential successor liability causes of action against Pfizer while not pursuing Pfizer as a defendant herein. The Discovery Master would like an update on this issue at the April 21, 2010 Discovery Master conference.
4. **In addition to the conferences previously ordered for Friday, May 7, 2010, and Wednesday, May 26, 2010, the Discovery Master shall conduct all day conferences on Tuesday, June 8, 2010 and Wednesday, June 23, 2010, commencing at 9:30 a.m., the locations for which are to be determined.**
