**In the Matter of the Philadelphia Water Department's Proposed Increase
in Water and Wastewater Rates FY 2009-2012**

STIPULATION REGARDING PA-JM-62 AND PA-JM-63

Whereas, on January 9, 2009, the Public Advocate propounded PA-JM-62 and PA-JM-63, seeking, inter alia, production of certain documents regarding Discontinuance Permits that were listed on the website of the City of Philadelphia;

Whereas, at the January 13, 2009 hearings, the parties recognized that schedules concerning Discontinuance Permits provided by the PWD in response to PA-JM-55 contained certain inaccuracies and miscalculations and should be corrected (Tr.1060);

Whereas, the PWD subsequently responded to PA-JM-62 and PA-JM-63, but did not produce the requested documents listed on the City's website index and did not explain what efforts had been made to locate those documents;


Whereas, on January 21, 2009, the Public Advocate notified the PWD that he considered the responses to PA-JM-62 and PA-JM-63 to be incomplete, and asked that the requested documents be produced or that evidence be provided substantiating that the PWD had made a good faith effort to obtain the documents and had concluded that they were no longer in existence;

Whereas, at the time of the Post-Hearing Conference on January 22, 2009, the PWD had not had the opportunity to supplement its responses to PA-JM-62 and PA-JM-63 or to correct the response to PA-JM-55;


Whereas, on January 22, 2009, the Hearing Officer admitted into evidence Exhibit PWD-39A, which was to be a Stipulation signed by the Public Advocate and by PWD counsel that attached the requested documents or otherwise indicated settlement of this discovery issue. Tr. 1199-1200.

Whereas, the PWD has produced the documents attached hereto as Exhibit A to complete and/or correct its responses to PA-JM-55, PA-JM-62 and PA-JM-63.

Now, therefore, the parties hereby stipulate this 10th day of February, 2009, that the PWD has fully responded to PA-JM-55, PA-JM-62 and PA-JM-63.
